We met at the Seaside Nature Center to pick up some tools and then headed to the Ft. Miles and Observation Tower parking lots. We split into 2 groups. One group worked on clearing the Pinelands trail with loppers, pruners and saws. The second group, armed with picker/grabbers, cleaned up trash around Ft. Miles and the Observation Tower where they collected about 60 pounds of trash. The groups combined for a total of 57.5 volunteer hours.

Hopefully there will be no more snow this winter as we can look forward to Spring. And with Spring comes the running events season. We are looking for volunteers to help with either of these two events.


- Sunday, April 6th, Oy Vey 5K Run/Walk: 3-4 volunteers needed for a relatively small event which
