# **FOCHSP Annual Membership Meeting UPDATE March 8, 2025**



### 2024 Volunteer Review

340 volunteers contributed 10,333.75 volunteer hours to Cape Henlopen State Park in 2024.

As usual, the Bike Barn came out as the top volunteering category followed by our highly attended events. The top three events, by volunteer hours, include the Holiday Boutique and Book Fair- 559 hrs., the Indoor Flea Market- 533 hrs. & Chocolate Tasting in the Park- 395 hrs. There were 32 volunteers that exceeded the 100 hours needed to receive a free Annual Park Pass. Many members contribute for a single event or even a few hours but every one of those important hours adds up. As the annual summary shows, volunteerism is in our DNA.

### **Get to Know Our Members – Randy Gabel**

Randy Gabel grew up in Hatfield, PA, a suburb of Philadelphia, and attended Penn State. After college he moved to northern Virginia where he lived for over 30 years.
